The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. with Furlong, Sorensen, Howard, Sauer and Kelly present. Chairperson Howard presiding.

On a motion by Furlong, second by Sauer, the agenda was approved as written. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, claims dated February 17, 2014 were approved in the amount of \$276,747.55. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Furlong, second by Sorensen, the Board authorized the Chairperson to execute an application for a FY2015 Governor's Traffic Safety Bureau Impaired Driving Grant in the amount of \$38,166.50. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Furlong, second by Sorensen, an ordinance amending the Muscatine County Zoning Ordinance to add youth and religious camps and retreat facilities as a permitted special use in the A-1 Agricultural District was approved on the second of three readings. Roll call vote: Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, minutes of the Monday, February 10, 2014 regular meeting were approved as written. Ayes: All.
