

Muscatine County Board of Supervisors
Monday, March 2, 2015 – Special Session

The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in special session at 7:00 P.M. with Bonebrake, Sorensen, Kelly, Sauer and Howard present. Chairperson Kelly presiding.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Bonebrake, the agenda was approved as written. Ayes: All.

A Public Hearing was called to order by Chairperson Kelly at 7:00 P.M. on the proposed Fiscal Year 2015/16 Muscatine County Budget. Charles Lorenson, 1808 Briarwood Lane, expressed concern about the budget because the County spent money on things probably not necessary such as lighting the Courthouse and he would like the Board to hold the budget to last year's level. Budget Coordinator Sherry Seright clarified that the Courthouse lighting project is not in this budget. Kelly stated the budget would have had a reduction if not for the MUSCOM communications upgrade. On a motion by Sorensen, second by Bonebrake, the public hearing was closed at 7:06 P.M. On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the Board approved Resolution #03-02-14-05 Adopting the Fiscal Year 2015/16 County Budget. Roll call vote: Ayes: All.

A Public Hearing was called to order by Chairperson Howard at 7:08 P.M. on proposed amendments to the Fiscal Year 2014/15 Muscatine County Budget. Budget Coordinator Sherry Seright reviewed the proposed amendments with the Board. No one spoke for or against the proposed amendments. On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the public hearing was closed at 7:12 P.M. Roll call vote: Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Bonebrake, the Board approved Resolution #03-02-14-06 Amending the Fiscal Year 2014/15 County Budget. Roll call vote: Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the Board approved Resolution #03-02-14-07 Fiscal Year 2014/15 Budget Appropriations. Roll call vote: Ayes: All.
