

Muscatine County Board of Supervisors
Monday, October 12, 2015

The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. with Howard, Sorensen, Kelly and Bonebrake present. Sauer was absent. Chairperson Kelly presiding.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Bonebrake, the agenda was approved as written. Ayes: All.

Ann Brumback thanked Susie Garrett for going above and beyond in performing her job as Medical Examiner Investigator during the hours after the death of Brumback's father. Brumback stated Garrett gave Brumback's mother peace and comfort in a time when no one could console her. Brumback also acknowledged Tom Summitt's help as one of the paramedics who was dispatched.
