

Muscatine County Board of Supervisors  
Monday, August 1, 2022

The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. with Holliday, Mather and Sorensen present. Saucedo and Sauer were absent. Vice-Chairperson Mather presiding.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Holliday, the agenda was approved as presented. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Holliday, the Board authorized the County Auditor, Tibe Vander Linden to sign an agreement with Cott Systems to digitize the Muscatine County real estate books with a not to exceed project cost of \$90,000 as the approved amount under the American Rescue Plan Act funds. Sorensen requested the project be hosted on-premise, however if this is not available, he would approve the project under the proposed Cott Cloud hosted management system. Vander Linden stated she will inquire with Cott Systems to determine if hosting the project on premise is possible and report to the Board. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Holliday, second by Sorensen, the Board approved the following utility permits: Lumen, Davenport, Iowa – bore 60-foot, three pair 24-gauge cable from pedestal to pedestal under 155<sup>th</sup> Street, Section 1-T77N-R01W; Alliant Energy, Lisbon, Iowa – replace existing overhead facilities with new underground facilities and upgrading to 25 kilovolt and new underground in back of right-of-way along residential lots and in easement on Noble Avenue, Section 8-T78N-R02W; and Eastern Iowa Light and Power REC, Wilton, Iowa – rebuilding new overhead line along Stewart Road and Ogilvie Avenue, setting new poles and anchors back of right-of-way, Sections 28, 29, 32 & 33-T76N-R02W. Ayes: All.

Assistant County Engineer Bryan Horesowsky updated the Board on secondary road projects.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Holliday, the Board approved the renewal application and ownership change for an Iowa Retail Class C Native Wines, Sunday Sales Permit and Outdoor Service Permit for Ardon Creek Vineyard & Winery, LLC, dba Ardon Creek Vineyard & Winery, 2391 Independence Avenue, Letts, Iowa. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Holliday, minutes of the July 25, 2022 regular meeting were approved as amended. Ayes: All.
