

Muscatine County Board of Supervisors
Monday, November 27, 2024

The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in special session at 9:00 A.M. with Mather, Sauer and Sorensen present. Chairperson Sorensen presiding. Kirchner and Chick were absent.

On a motion by Sauer, second by Mather, the agenda was approved as presented. Ayes: All.

The Board met as a Board of Canvassers to canvass the recount of the U.S. Representative District 1 race for the November 5, 2024 General Election. County Auditor Tibe Vander Linden reviewed the recount tally. Vander Linden stated the Recount Board certified the following changes: Election Day Precincts Tally: No Change/100% accurate tally with 12,021 ballots cast with a scattering of 32 write-in votes, 338 undervotes and 2 overvotes; Absentee Tally: Mariannette Miller-Meeks 3,543 votes (one additional vote), Christina Bohannon 4,074 votes (one less vote) with a scattering of 10 write-in votes, 224 under-votes and 1 over-vote for a total of 7,852 Absentee ballots cast.

The Board of Supervisors certified the following to be a true and correct abstract of the recount of votes of the U.S. Representative District 1 race for the November 5, 2024 General Election. There was a total of 19,873 votes cast. Mariannette Miller-Meeks received 10,138 votes Christina Bohannon received 9,128 votes, and there was a scattering of 42 write-in votes, 562 under-votes and 3 over-votes.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:02 A.M.
