The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. with Chick, Kirchner, Mather, Sauer and Sorensen present. Chairperson Mather presiding.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the agenda was approved as presented. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sauer, second by Sorensen, the Board approved a utility permit with Eastern Iowa Light & Power, Wilton, Iowa – bore 150th Street with 2-inch duct 1/0 jacketed cable depth to be four feet below the bottom of the cable. Section 25, T78N-R2W. Ayes: All.

County Engineer Bryan Horesowsky updated the Board on secondary road projects and Stewart Road project.

County Development Director Eric Furnas reviewed Change Order #3 stating the additional work is for foundation step wall repairs at the Community Services building due to deteriorated brick.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the Board approved Change Order #3 with Wolfe Contracting, Inc., in the amount of \$8,350.10, for additional work at the Community Services building. Ayes: All.

Furnas updated the Board on the Deep Lakes Campground electrical and well projects.

On a motion by Sauer, second by Sorensen, the Board approved the minutes of November 10, 2025 regular meeting, November 12, 2025 special meeting and the amended October 27, 2025 regular meeting minutes. Ayes: All.
