

Muscatine County Board of Supervisors
Tuesday, November 18, 2025

The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:10 A.M. with Kirchner, Mather, Sauer and Sorensen present. Chick was absent. Chairperson Mather presiding.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Kirchner, the agenda was approved as presented. Ayes: All.

The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met as a Board of Canvassers and County Auditor Tibe Vander Linden presented the second-tier results of the City and School Elections held on November 4, 2025, where Muscatine County was the control county.

CITY OF WILTON

Mayor (two-year term) – there were 106 votes cast: Keith W. Stanley received 101 votes and there was a scattering of 5 votes. Keith W. Stanley was elected.

Councilmember At-Large (four-year term, two positions) – there were 186 votes cast: Michael Rohwer received 88 votes, Allen Bill Voss received 94 votes, and there was a scattering of 4 votes. Michael Rohwer and Allen Bill Voss were elected.

LOUISA-MUSCATINE SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER (four-year term, two positions) – there were 1,142 votes cast: Jeff Riggan received 539 votes, Stacie Bieri-Ziegenhorn received 548 votes and there was a scattering of 55 votes. Jeff Riggan and Stacie Bieri-Ziegenhorn were elected.

LOUISA-MUSCATINE SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER – To Fill A Vacancy – No Candidate filed for the seat therefore a write-in race occurred. There were 136 votes cast. Scott Wilson received 75 votes and scattering received 61 votes. Scott Wilson was elected.

LOUISA-MUSCATINE SCHOOL- PUBLIC MEASURE QF – Shall the Board of Directors of the Louisa-Muscatine Community School District in the Counties of Louisa and Muscatine, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$8,895,000 to provide funds to build, furnish, and equip an addition to the junior/senior high school building for a competition gymnasium, including locker rooms and related spaces? There were 759 votes cast. Yes received 380 and No received 379. The Public Measure was not adopted as the 60% threshold was not met.

WEST LIBERTY SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER (four-year term, two positions) – There were 722 votes cast: Josh Gingerich received 385 votes and Rebecca Vargas received 327 votes and there was a scattering of 10 votes. Josh Gingerich and Rebecca Vargas were elected.

WILTON SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER (four-year term, two positions) – there were 245 votes cast: Tara Oien received 126 votes and Alex White received 114 votes and there was a scattering of 5 votes. Tara Oien and Alex White were elected.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:04 A.M.
