- MOU FY25 JAG Grant with City of Muscatine

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
FFY 2025 Justice Assistance Grant Local Package
O-BJA-2025-172542

1. This memorandum of understanding is entered into between the County of Muscatine, Iowa and the City of Muscatine, Iowa.
2. The purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to describe the planned allocation of the FFY 2025 Justice Assistance Grant Direct Award (JAG Direct or Local Solicitation) received by the parties to this agreement.
3. The parties anticipate that the JAG Direct award for FFY 2025 will be \$10,294.00.
4. The parties agree that the total funds received from the JAG Direct program shall be allocated to the City of Muscatine, Iowa and the equipment purchased, as a result of JAG award, will be utilized by both the City and County of Muscatine, Iowa. The City of Muscatine will receive \$10,294 and Muscatine County will receive \$0.00. The City of Muscatine, Iowa, as the designated applicant and fiscal agent for the JAG Direct program, shall disburse said funds according to the terms of this memorandum of understanding and all requirements of applicable grant programs and grant administering authorities.
6. These funds shall be used for state and local initiatives, technical assistance, training, personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, and information systems for criminal justice as required by the JAG direct Grant Program. This memorandum of understanding shall not be construed to impose any additional liability upon a party nor shall it confer rights upon any third person.
7. The undersigned execute this agreement pursuant to duly enacted authorizing resolutions of each party.

Monday, March 30, 2026

The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. with Chick, Kirchner, Mather and Sauer present. Sorensen was absent. Chairperson Chick presiding.

On a motion by Sauer, second by Mather, the agenda was approved as presented. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sauer, second by Kirchner, the Board approved claims dated March 30th, 2026, in the amount of \$333,054.37. Ayes: All.

A Public Hearing was called to order by Chairperson Chick at 9:01 A.M. on proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and cost estimate for the Muscatine County Engineer Satellite Facility Project. Mike Nolan, Horizon Architecture, reviewed a Notice to Bidders document which stated the proposed plans, specifications and total opinion of probable costs for the project. No public comments were made. On a motion by Mather, second by Kirchner, the public hearing was closed at 9:02 A.M. Roll call vote: Ayes: All.

WHEREAS, the Muscatine County Board of Supervisors has retained Horizon Architecture to provide consulting architectural/engineering services for the Muscatine County Engineer Satellite Facility Project; and

WHEREAS, Horizon Architecture has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract and estimated cost for the project, which documents have been on file and available for public inspection in the Muscatine County Zoning Office since Monday, March 23, 2026; and

WHEREAS, following notice of public hearing published in accordance with the law, a public hearing was held on Monday, March 30, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. in the Muscatine County Administration Building at which members of the public were allowed to be heard on the issue of the Muscatine County Engineer Satellite Facility Project, and on the documents prepared in connection therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Muscatine County Board of Supervisors:

1. That the plans, specifications, form of contract and estimated cost of the Muscatine County Engineer Satellite Facility Project are hereby approved.
2. That Muscatine County shall solicit sealed bids for the proposed improvement in accordance with the law.

3. That bids must be received as described in the Notice to Bidders on or before the 23rd day of April, 2026.
4. That bids shall be publicly announced at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, April 27, 2026 at the Muscatine County Board of Supervisors meeting.
5. That the sealed bids must be accompanied by a bid security equal to ten (10) percent of the bid.

RESOLUTION #03-30-26-02

RESOLUTION TAKING ACTION TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING AND ADDITIONAL ACTION ON PROPOSAL TO ENTER INTO GENERAL OBLIGATION LOAN AGREEMENT AND TO BORROW MONEY THEREUNDER TO FACILITATE THE REPURPOSING OF PRIOR BOND PROCEEDS

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of Muscatine County, Iowa (the "County"), proposes to enter into a General Obligation Loan Agreement (the "Loan Agreement") and to borrow money thereunder in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,025,000 pursuant to the provisions of Section 331.402 and Section 331.441(2)(b)(5) of the Code of Iowa for the purpose of paying the costs, to that extent, of: (a) renovating the Deep Lakes Park Maintenance Facility (\$100,000); (b) undertaking general physical plant maintenance and repairs to County facilities (\$200,000); (c) undertaking repairs to the Community Services Building (\$275,000); and (d) improving the County geothermal field for heating and cooling County buildings (\$450,000) (the "Projects"), and it is now necessary to fix a date of meeting of the Board of Supervisors at which it is proposed to take action to enter into the Loan Agreement and to give notice thereof as required by such law; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of entering into an additional credit facility, the Board intends to use the borrowing authority relative to the Loan Agreement to repurpose proceeds remaining from the prior issuance of the County's General Obligation Levee Improvements Note, Series 2022 to pay costs of the Projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Muscatine County, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. This Board will meet on April 13, 2026, at the Muscatine County Administration Building, Muscatine, Iowa, at 9 o'clock a.m., at which time and place the hearing will be held and proceedings will be instituted and action taken to enter into the Loan Agreement to facilitate the repurposing of prior bond proceeds.

Section 2. The County Auditor is hereby directed to give notice of the proposed action on the Loan Agreement and setting forth the amount and purpose thereof, the time when and place where the said meeting will be held by publication at least once and not less than 4 and not more than 20 days before the date selected for the meeting, in a legal newspaper which has a general circulation in the County. The notice shall be in substantially the following form:

(GENERAL OBLIGATION)

The Board of Supervisors of Muscatine County, Iowa (the “County”), will meet on April 13, 2026, at the Muscatine County Administration Building, Muscatine, Iowa, at 9 o’clock a.m., for the purpose of instituting proceedings and taking action on a proposal to enter into a loan agreement (the “Loan Agreement”) and to borrow money thereunder to facilitate the repurposing of prior bond proceeds in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,025,000 for the purpose of paying the costs, to that extent, of: (a) renovating the Deep Lakes Park Maintenance Facility (\$100,000); (b) undertaking general physical maintenance and repairs to County facilities (\$200,000); (c) undertaking repairs to the Community Services Building (\$275,000); and (d) improving the geothermal field for heating and cooling County buildings (\$450,000).

The Loan Agreement is proposed to be entered into, and bonds will be issued thereunder, pursuant to authority contained in Section 331.402 of the Code of Iowa. To the extent and additional credit facility were to be undertaken, the Loan Agreement would constitute a general obligation of the County.

The County intends to use its borrowing authority under the Loan Agreement to repurpose a portion of the proceeds of a prior issuance of General Obligation Levee Improvements Note, Series 2022, dated July 21, 2022. As a result, there will be no annual increase in property taxes on a residential property with an actual valuation of one hundred thousand dollars resulting from the County entering into the Loan Agreement.

At that time and place, oral or written objections may be filed or made to the proposal to enter into the Loan Agreement to facilitate the repurposing of prior bond proceeds. After receiving objections, the County may determine to enter into the Loan Agreement, in which case, the decision will be final unless appealed to the District Court within fifteen (15) days thereafter.

**TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE RURAL SERVICES FUND TO THE
SECONDARY ROADS FUND**

WHEREAS, it is desired to authorize the Auditor periodically to transfer sums from the Rural Services Fund to the Secondary Roads Fund; and

WHEREAS, said transfers must be in accordance with Sections 331.429 and 331.432 of the Code of Iowa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Muscatine County Board of Supervisors that the Auditor is authorized to transfer \$1,140,000 from the Rural Services Fund to the Secondary Roads Fund.
